CSF 609 – Exploring English Language & Culture

Emphasis will be on spoken communication: fluency, comprehension, grammar, vocabulary, idioms, and pronunciation, but the skills of reading, writing, organizing, and studying will also be involved. Topics such as cultural figures, social conventions, comparing cultures, news and events, and entertainment will be drawn from experience, text, interesting articles, TV, film presentations, and the internet. Various aspects and conventions of U.S. culture provide the content for this course as a way to develop language skills.
